“Who Are Abraham’s Children? What Are the Goals and Obstacles of Jewish-Christian-Muslim Dialogue?”

Dr. Mahmoud Ayoub, Scholar in Residence, Hartford Seminary; Professor Emeritus of Islamic Studies and Comparative Religion, Temple University

These questions will be explored in a discussion with Dr. Ayoub who has authored a number of books in English and Arabic in the area of Islam and Inter-religious dialogue. The most notable are “*Redemptive Suffering in Islam*” and “*The Qur’an and Its Interpreters*” (2 volumes to date). Two of his recent works are “*Crisis of Muslim History: Religion and Politics in Early Islam*” and “*Islam in Faith and History*.” Currently he is working on the third volume of “*The Qur’an and Its Interpreters*.”
